Cornelia Arts Building invites submissions for the 23rd Annual Holiday Art Sale. **Submission deadline is October 1, 2010 or until full.** This show features fine art and fine craft in all media. *Work need not be holiday themed.* All work must be hand-crafted by the artist-exhibitor: imported items for resale are not permitted. Work that has been produced with commercial molds, kits, pre-fabricated forms, or other commercial methods is NOT permitted.

Artists must submit 4 **digital images** of work to be exhibited. Images may be sent via e-mail to 1800Cornelia@gmail.com, or may be sent on a CD. JPG files should be no larger than 2MB each. ZAPP format is acceptable. Label JPG files: lastname_firstname_medium. Jury process is based solely on images submitted - make sure they are clear. All non-Cornelia resident exhibitors must submit JPGs for 2010 jury. If accepted, work displayed must match media in JPGs. Artists will be required to remove work which does not match submission.

Show dates for 2010 are Friday through Sunday, Dec. 3rd - 5th. An opening reception is planned for Friday evening with complimentary refreshments. Set up is Friday from 2pm - 5:30pm, Saturday 8am - 10 am, and Sunday 10am - 11am. Other set-up times may be available, call for more information if needed. Exhibitors who pack and leave early will not be allowed back in 2011.

Hallway wall and some room spaces are available. Hall spaces are 8 foot high and vary in length from 8' to 14'. Some hallway spaces are extremely shallow. Tables for exhibitors in hallways cannot be deeper than 24" due to space considerations. Exhibitors should bring their own chair. Exhibitors should consider shelving units or wall displays. Exhibitors are responsible for bringing their own lights, extension cords, etc., as some spaces are not well lit. Exhibition fee for artists with studios in the building is \$60 per artist. Fee for all other artists is \$140. These fees are needed to cover costs of printing and other advertising. Show fees are non-refundable after acceptance. Postcards will be available to artists after November 1.

Artists will be sent notification of acceptance, rejection, or wait-list status in late October.

All proceeds from art sales go to the artist. Artists will need an Illinois tax number prior to setting up on the day of the show. Tax numbers are available at the State of Illinois Building.
